17 THE FINISH

17.1 Finishing line

The finishing line runs due north from the Darling Associates Buoy for approximately 0.1nm. A committee vessel (which may be "Zulu", a 46' white Nicholson yacht), displaying a blue flag with a white border and seahorse (constant blue light at night) may be on station at the end of the line.

Yachts are reminded to take their own finishing times (BST) together with the names of the yachts, if any, ahead and astern. Finishing times shall be delivered to the RORC as soon as possible.

2012 MORGAN CUP RACE SI AMENDMENT NO. 1

SUPPLEMENT TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Amend Sailing Instruction "20 TRACKING" to read:

20 TRACKING

20.1 Yachts trialing for the Brewin Dolphin Commodores' Cup are required to carry RORC Loggers for the duration of the race. They shall use their best endeavours to ensure the Logger remains switched to the "log" setting and to keep it in a position with a clear view of the sky.

Loggers must be collected from the RORC rib (a blue rib displaying a blue flag with a white border and seahorse) in the vicinity of the Identity Gate before the start of the race. Loggers must be returned to the RORC Representative in Cowes after the finish of the race. To arrange the return of the logger please call the RORC Representative +44 (0) 7825 007 035 immediately after finishing.
