- » Entry to the Cowes Clubhouse is through the main gate only, disabled access can be arranged on request.

- » Tickets will be issued electronically.
- » At certain times, members may be asked to show their digital membership card, a ticket to an event, and competitors may be asked to show their wristbands, to gain access to the club.
- » Guests, family, and friends of members are invited to obtain a guest wristband during Cowes Week, or must be accompanied by a RORC member, when using the Clubhouse.

## CODE OF CONDUCT

Children remain the responsibility of their parents or responsible adult when they are in the club buildings, marquees and grounds.

RORC cannot be deemed responsible for any loss of possessions or injury sustained while on the premises.

The purchase of alcohol for under 18s is not permitted. The Club operates a Challenge 25 policy - anyone buying alcohol who appears to be below 25 may be asked to provide an acceptable form of ID. Alcohol will be confiscated if the Club's licence is deemed to be at risk.

A dress code is set for individual events.

Antisocial behaviour will not be permitted.

Smoking is prohibited in the clubhouse and any area where food is being served.
